an exact date for occupation. The contractor has been to the school and staked out the site. They understand the urgency and are working around the clock to make the move-in happen soon.

I miss all of our students and families and am looking forward to the day we are all on campus. Please continue to pray for our school, faculty and staff, students and parents, and church as we continue to pray for you.
